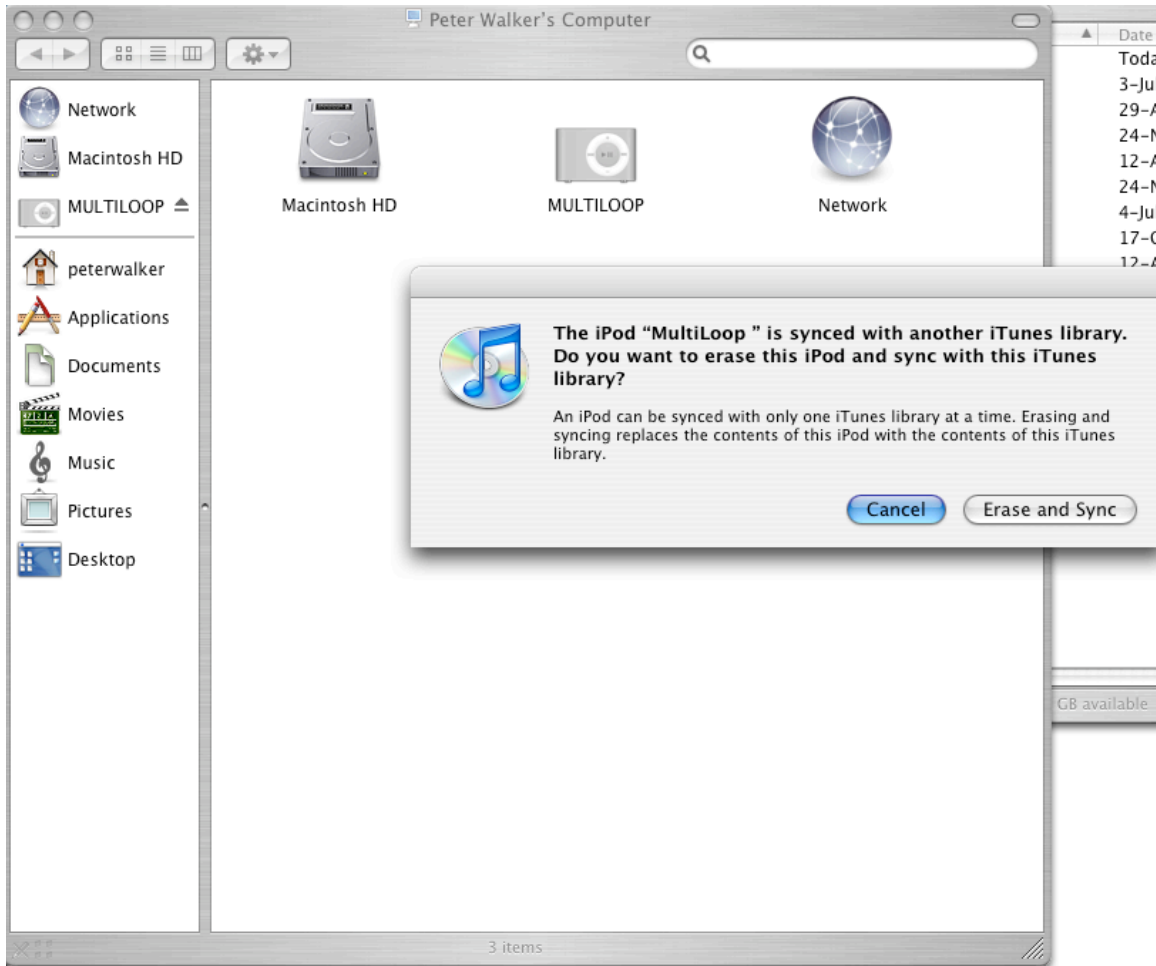


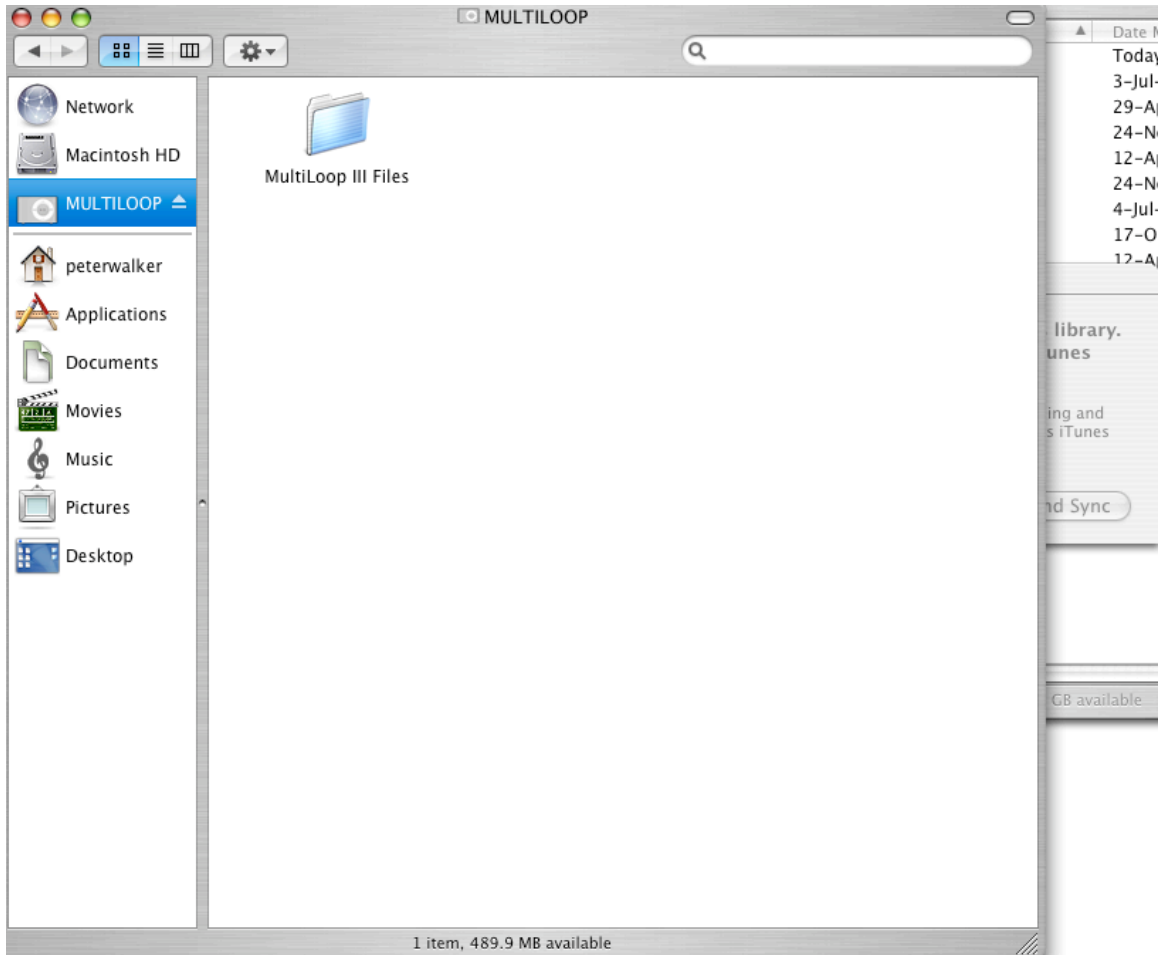
Installing MultiLoop III From an iPod

1. If your installation software comes in an iPod, remove all the packaging and mount the iPod securely in its cradle (if supplied) and plug in the iPod to the USB. Turn the iPod on. Your screen should appear like this.



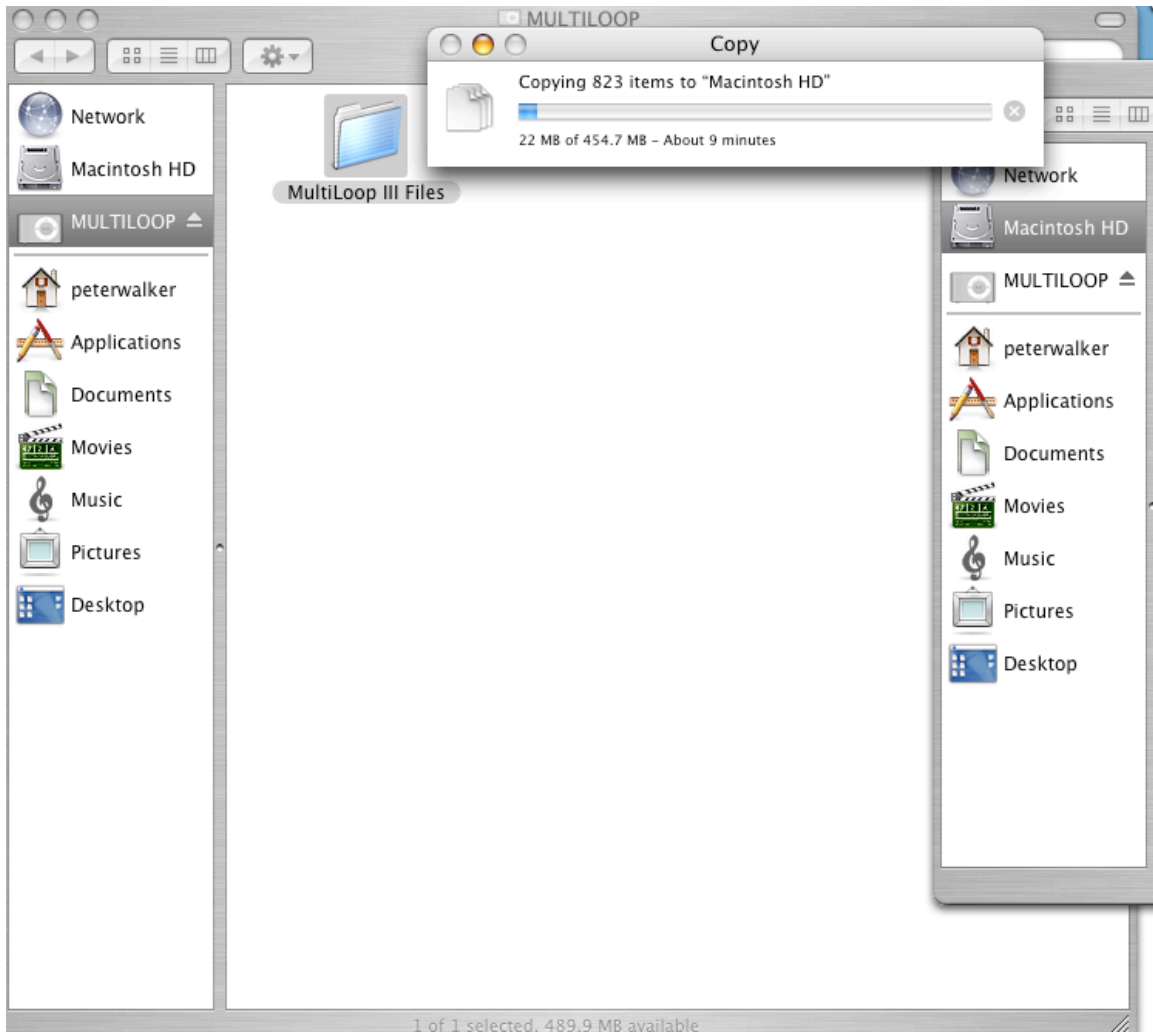
IMPORTANT: Ignore the dialog box and do not Erase and Sync your iPod with your library or the MultiLoop III software will be deleted. Selecting Cancel will dismount the disk. – do not do this either – proceed to step 2.

2. Click on the iPod icon in the left panel of the Finder window to access the iPod disk, “MultiLoop”. Clicking on the iPod MultiLoop disk will highlight and select it (do not click on the vertical arrow or the disk will dismount). You should see the installation file folder in the left panel.

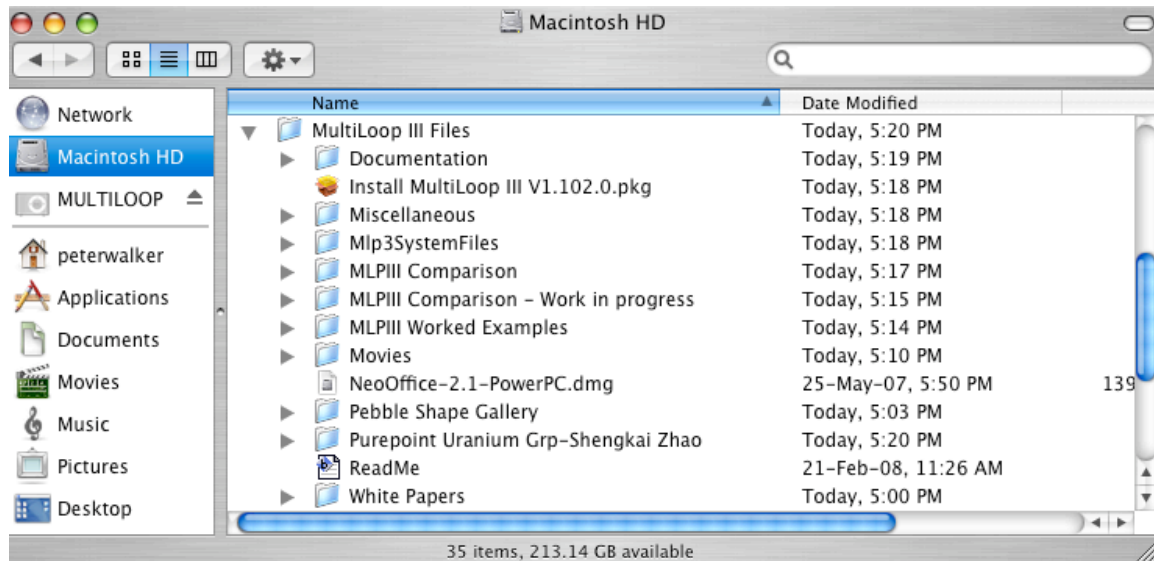


3. Copy the installation files in the MultiLoop III folder to your hard drive. To do this, select the folder with the mouse (Click on the folder icon and drag it to the target disk, in this case Macintosh HD, shown in the second Finder window on the right side of the picture below.)

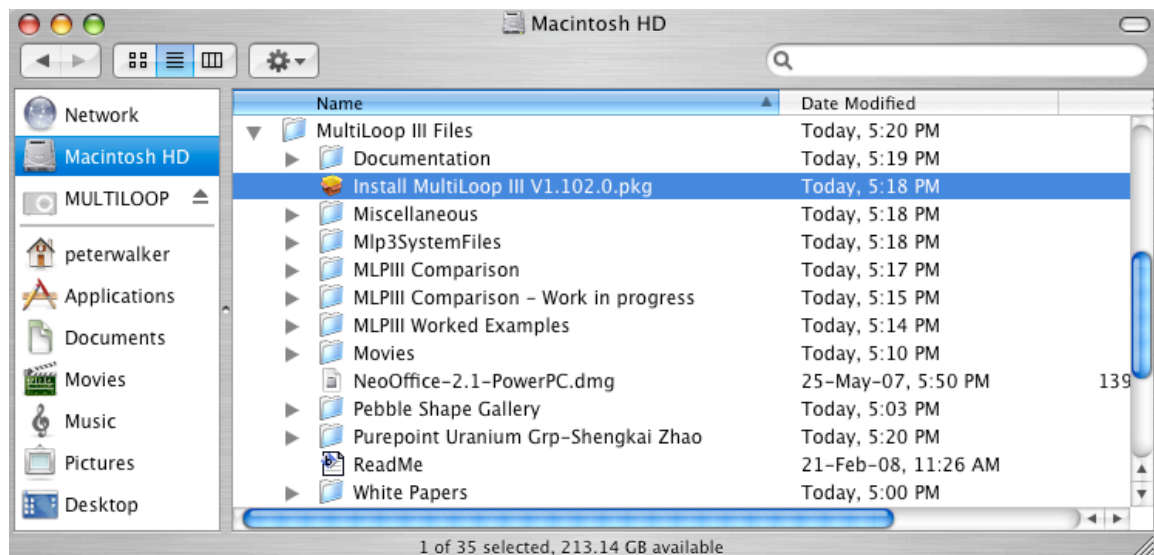
The copy progress bar will appear.



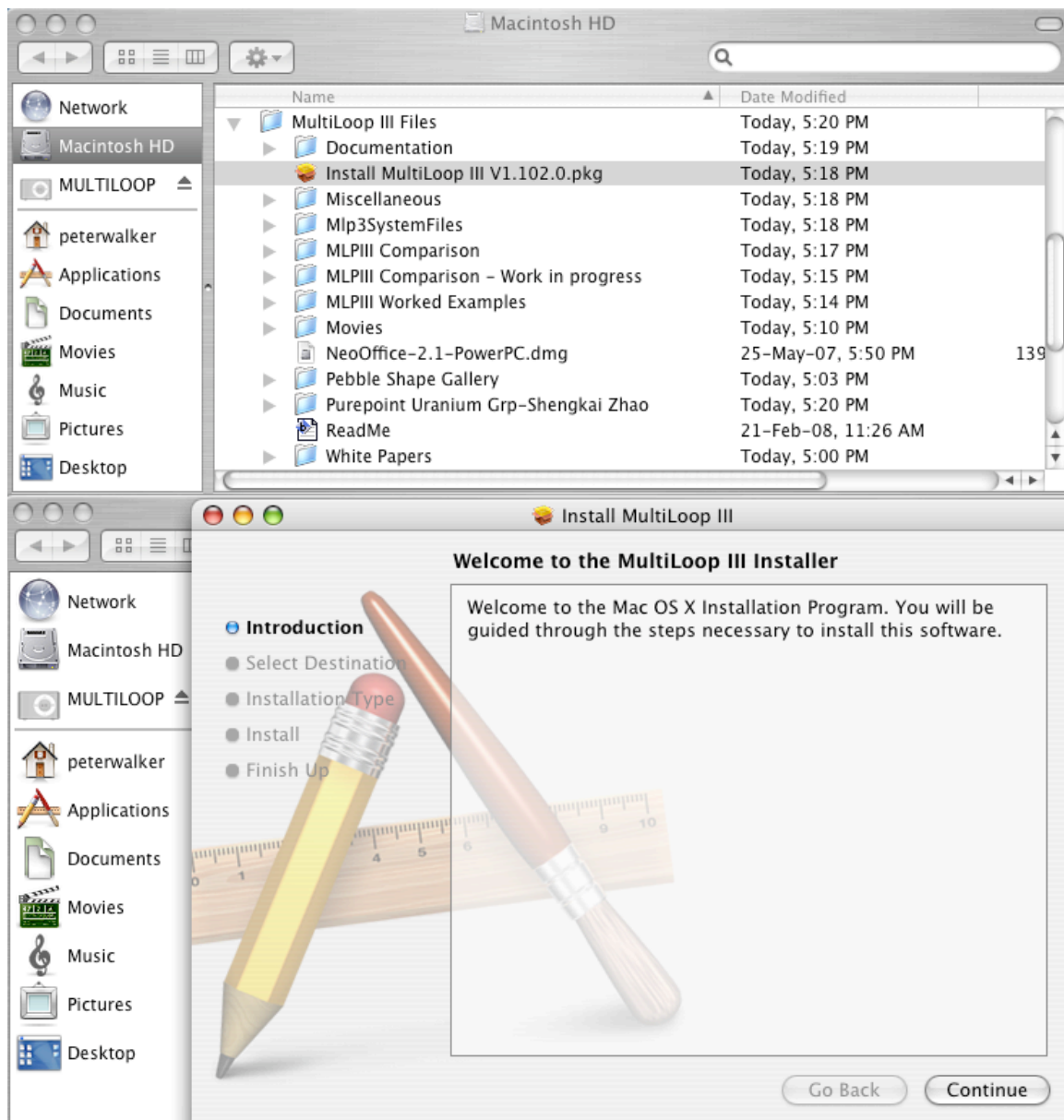
4. When the copy is complete, click on the installation folder you have just copied. You should see the MultiLoop III installation files.



Click on the install package:



5. Follow the installer instructions. To install software, you may need a password.



6. When the installation is complete, click on the iPod dialogue from step 1. To dismount the iPod, select cancel. When you are happy with the installation, and are sure the files have been transferred to your computer, it is not necessary to keep the Multiloop III installation files on the iPod.



After the iPod is dismounted, it can be removed from the USB port and turned off.
